I remain very grateful for all of the Albemarle District GRs and Officers, who have persistently been engaged and dedicated to their groups and to the district; they are doing an amazing job and I feel so fortunate to serve with them.

This report includes news and information that has occurred since the spring 2021 assembly.

Our district normally has meetings every day of the week and there are currently (9) active meetings, some meeting virtually only and some in hybrid status.
