- Currently have 7 Open Al Anon Meetings in our District, including 1 Beginner Meeting
 - All meetings went virtual for several months during the pandemic
 - Currently, 3 meetings are face to face only.
 - 4 meetings are hybrid, including the Beginner's Meeting.
 - At least one of the F2F meetings is considering adding a hybrid option.
 - The majority of our meetings consist of members who attended prior to COVID.
 - At least one meeting has regular attendance in double digits, most others tend to be under 10 participants.
- Our Public Outreach Project of placing "How Al-Anon Works" books in libraries was placed on hold due to the pandemic.
- Our District was able to increase the amount of our contribution to the Area, The Tidewater Service Center and WSO during the pandemic as our expenses at home have been minimal.
- Our District has funded a Zoom account for one year, to which all meetings have access should they choose to utilize it.
- We have held several District events this year 2 virtual Speaker Meetings and one in person Speaker Meeting.
- Challenges include attracting newcomers and, filling and rotating service positions.
