- 1. Monday, March 1, 2021, WSO is announcing a **new job posting for Director of Programs**, to begin in September 2021. The job requirements are:
  - A BA or BS in Organizational Leadership, Business Management or related field.
  - A minimum of 5 years of work experience in a related field.
  - 7 to 10 years of Al-Anon membership.
  - Al-Anon experience beyond the group level.
  - No current or previous A. A. membership.
  - Experience in a non-profit preferred.

- 2. From the January 2021 Board of Trustees Quarterly meeting reports:
  - From the Chair:
    - o Contributions for 2020 were over \$3 million.
    - Our region, the Southeast, will put forth a nominee to fill out the last year of the current panel. Voting takes place at the 2021 WSC in April. There is still a vacancy for the next 3 year term.
  - From the Policy Committee:
    - Multiple revisions to the Service Manual are being sent to the 2021 WSC for approval.
      Please note that all the revisions originated from the Policy Committee with no input from the Delegates.
  - From the Finance Committee:
    - There is a net increase to net assets of \$509,190.
    - o This reflects an increase in contributions plus a decrease in expenses.
    - o The Reserve Fund had a gain of \$227,530 for the month of Dec. 2020.
