- \$61,000 bank balance at the end of Q3-21
- Income is at 50% of projected for the year, and should be at 75%
- Contributions are down significantly, likely due to lack of face to face meetings
- IRS is considering our explanation of an administrative error causing a problem with our tax ID number, and we should know more by the end of the year
- Delegate expenses and Alateen expenses will likely increase next year as we return to more face to face meetings
- Discussion took place about the need for increased electronic donations
- Bruce reminded attendees to make sure all donations include a group number

- The 2022 WSC theme will be "Enhancing our Recovery through Abundance, Unity, and Understanding"
- Our demographics remain largely the same, despite our efforts at diversity
- The 2022 WSC will visit Stepping Stones, the home of Bill W. and Lois W., in Tarrytown, NY
- Val P. is our first ever nominee for Southeast Regional Trustee
- Delegates will be meeting virtually with the Board of Trustees on November 6, 2021 for their quarterly meeting
- Terry encouraged the use of the 2018 Bias Inventory presentation, posted on the website under 2021 Spring Assembly Dialogue with the Delegate
- The 2021 WSC Summary is now available online and by hardcopy
- The Service Manual will be updated in 2022 it includes policy changes; everyone needs a copy
- Terry will be hosting 3 virtual DR 101 orientation sessions this fall
- Terry outlined the need for a Task Force to create a policy transforming our electronic meetings to AFG meetings
