Events/Projects since last Assembly:

- **Delegate visit.** Stacy L visited the July district meeting and provided context to a discussion about District funds and highlighted the WSO's continuing interest in electronic meetings.
- **GR resignation.** One group lost a GR who was working in a temporary capacity and resigned in July 2022. A member volunteered to be the new CMA, a position vacated with the GR resignation.
- **Springfield 12&12 AFG**, Sunday Night meeting has successfully transitioned to a hybrid meeting.
- DR attended the Northern Virginia Service Center DR picnic on 16 July which led to Annandale/Springfield, Arlington, Falls Church/McLean/Vienna Districts agreeing to sponsor an in-person breakfast for all Al-Anon members.
