- Finance While literature were slightly below YTD budget, our contributions hit a record 3.3 million!! Overall 2022 came in under budget by approx. 224k. Great news on the budget front please thank all our members for their personal contributions that are necessary to make sure Al-Anon is here for the future. On a lower note, the reserve fund did take a loss in 2022 (we had a nice gain last year) but that is not really surprising due to market and economy.
- **Road Trip** The 2023 Road Trip will be held on October 28, 2023 in Southern California. Information about applying to host the 2024 Road Trip will be available at the WSC.
- International Convention Registration is \$200 through May 9, 2023 and will be \$225 after. For the first time, the convention will also be hybrid! The registration fee is \$145 and includes access to all 3 Big Meetings (speakers), various sessions and access to the event app to connect with all attendees.
- **Thought and Task Forces** The Board chose 3 topics based on conversations discussed by members on various AFG Connects communities. The work has already begun by the Delegates and will continue throughout 2023 to be presented at the 2024 WSC. The topics are:
