Updates since last meeting:

- Events or projects the District has completed since last meeting
 - o Voted in a new DR for the next 3-year term
 - o Voted in a new alternate DR for the next 3-year term
 - o Researched putting together an Outreach Workshop
 - o **Moment of Remembrance Proposal**
At our June district meeting, a GR brought a proposal for a "Moment of Remembrance" to be added near the beginning of the General Session at each Fall and Spring Assembly—a brief reading

and moment of silence honoring Al-Anon members who have lost loved ones to the disease of alcoholism. A motion to bring this proposal to VAWSC passed among GRs in attendance.  - Letting the groups in our district know that both the District Treasurer and District Secretary service positions will open up in October.
 - Planning an Outreach Workshop

 - One group is considering doing a group inventory.
 - Several groups have all of their service positions filled.
 - One group has a Fellowship Lunch once a month after the meeting.
 - One group recently celebrated their 70th Anniversary!
 - One group works on each step or tradition as long as the group wants to, then does a small group conscience to determine when to move on, allowing for greater depth into each one.
- Challenges
 - We've only had a DR for the past 3 years, so we're still trying to connect and coordinate as a district.
 - We have 2 inactive groups.
 - We have 2 other groups that don't have a GR.
 - We have low attendance of GRs at the district meeting.
