Activity Since Last Meeting

Public Outreach

Emily, our Public Outreach Coordinator, continues to lead active local and cross-district outreach efforts.

- Bilingual Al-Anon business cards were created with a QR code that links to Area-wide meeting information so the cards can be used by multiple districts.
- The Fairfax County Public Library system accepted five copies each of three Al-Anon and Alateen books: "One Day at a Time in Alateen," "Opening Our Hearts, Transforming Our Lives," and "From Survival to Recovery." This has been a collaborative outreach project involving several Northern Virginia districts.
- Participation at July youth wellness event held at Galilee United Methodist Church, Sterling, VA.

Alateen and AMIAS

- The Leesburg Alateen meeting has reported attendance of approximately ten young people, including newcomers and participants traveling from outside the immediate area.
- The Reston Alateen has sufficient AMIAS now but have not reported teens attending.
- The Leesburg and Reston groups have discussed having hybrid options so teens can attend both meetings even if they cannot get to them in person.
- One new candidate's AMIAS paperwork was completed and approved. One AMIAS did not recertify.

Group Representation

Since the Spring Assembly, the District added one Group Representative for a group that had been without representation for a number of years. Another group transitioned from one GR to a replacement.

Plans and Future Activities

- The District will begin planning its fall workshop at the July 28 meeting.
- The District has discussed creating a printed Loudoun District meeting booklet.

Successes

- The spring workshop committee worked collaboratively and produced a well-received event.
- Hybrid options were piloted for teens to attend both Alateen district meetings.
- Our Public Outreach Coordinator continues to generate creative projects and build strong cross-district partnerships.
- District members have continued stepping forward to support outreach, Alateen, workshops, and group-record updates.

Challenges

- Attendance by Group Representatives at District meetings continues to be lower than we would like, and several groups do not currently have an active GR.
- The Alternate District Secretary and Alternate District Treasurer positions remain open.
- Uncertainty surrounding the Northern Virginia Service Center

Goals

- Complete plans for the fall District workshop and begin promotion early.
- Continue recruiting, certifying, and supporting AMIAS members.
- Continue strengthening the two Alateen meetings and helping young people participate in Area and regional opportunities.
- Complete the printed Loudoun District meeting booklet.
- Increase GR participation in District meetings and service.
- Continue public outreach through libraries, community events, and cross-district partnerships.
