We have 10 Al-Anon Family Group meetings in the Fairfax District with 2 hybrid meetings and 8 virtual-only meetings. Several of the virtual meetings intend to stay this way due to convenience and accessibility. Attendance continues to be stable and oftentimes there are newcomers.

I am very grateful for all the GRs in our District and their dedication to their respective groups and to Al-Anon as a whole. It's been an honor to serve with each and every one of them. I am stepping away from my position as DR; hopefully, someone will come forward to be elected at the next District meeting on February 15<sup>th</sup>.

Group contributions to the District have been on target. Our funds actually increased due to lack of expenses relevant to Covid and a virtual Fall Assembly. A percentage of the funds were distributed to various service arms while holding a prudent amount in reserve.

Current challenges include learning about and adapting to new geographic dynamics with electronic meetings. One of our groups may elect a new GR who will reside in southern Virginia while their (possibly) new Treasurer actually resides in North Carolina.

Current goals continue to include increasing Outreach during and after a pandemic, possibly creating an Alateen meeting, and increasing diversity by starting a Spanish-speaking Al-Anon Family Group (AFG) in Fairfax, VA.
